Priscilla Mills is an attorney who practiced civil rights and personal injury law for 18 years and observed first-hand the impact that physical and mental impairments can have on an individual's work and work life expectancy. In 2001, she took a position as an Affirmative Action and Equal Opportunity Specialist with Northern Arizona University, subsequently becoming the Director of the Equal Opportunity Office, the ADA/504 Coordinator, and the university's chief harassment and discrimination investigator and compliance officer for affirmative action, civil rights and Title IX. As part of her duties, she has been responsible for the disability accommodation process for the university's over 4,500 faculty, administrators and staff. Priscilla is now the Assistant Vice President for Equity Compliance supervising the NAU Equity and Access Office and the Disability Resources Office, and is the Executive Director of the Center for University Access and Inclusion. Priscilla lives in Sedona and also does consulting in her areas of expertise.
